## CONDITIONALLY REGISTERED MOTORCYCLES

It is very important if you have a motorcycle(s) on CONDITIONAL (HISTORIC) REGISTRATION, that your Club fees are paid by the 30th of June each year. If the fees are not paid, you are an UNFINANCIAL MEMBER and therefore your motorcycle is by law UNREGISTERED and UNINSURED and your Log Book cannot be endorsed by the Club. It is the responsibility of the Club to maintain the CONDITIONAL REGISTRATION system, and part of that responsibility is to notify the registrar of people who are no longer FINANCIAL MEMBERS of the Club. This is a legal requirement.

**In order to gain 'Conditional (Historic) Registration', your first registered bike must be a BSA. This is a constitutional requirement of the BSA Owners' Club of SA.**
